New Business

Topic for Discussion: CRC registrations

- Sam: The price for CRC registrations for Areas is changing,
 - previously, all registrations purchased between January and March were \$20 per registration
 - initial purchase is \$20 per registration then after that, \$30 per registrations
- Should we wait a few months to save money and for CRC to elect a new chair and treasurer?
- Heidi asks if there's a process for distributing registrations
 - Louis says basically, no
- Louis explains that we started buying CRC registrations in place of donating to Region because of disagreements with Region's handling of finances
- Barry says CRC registrations are primarily bought to support CRC, the logistics of distribution are a secondary concern

- Saoirse says does it matter to withhold funds if CRC registration purchase is essentially a donation?
- Samir says yes, we have a duty to be responsible with our money
- Heidi asks that since policy says we buy registrations every month, do we have to change policy to withhold purchasing until a later date?
- Felix says \$20 registrations are easier on the area
- Topic passes: Money will be set aside, but purchase of registrations will be delayed until a later date to purchase more CRC registrations for \$20
